

Grade 6 Entrance Exam Honors Language Arts

The Grade 6 Honors Entrance Exam is a two-part exam designed to evaluate students' reading and writing skills. All questions and tasks are aligned with the Grade 6 curriculum.

Part A: Reading Comprehension

- Students will read a passage and answer questions that test their understanding of the text.
- Multiple Choice Questions
- Passages will include fictional story, non-fictional article
- Key skills assessed include:
 - Identifying main ideas and key details.
 - Making inferences and drawing conclusions.
 - Analyzing the author's purpose.

Part B: Narrative Writing

- Students will write a narrative based on a picture prompt.
- The narrative should demonstrate:
 - A clear beginning, middle, and end.
 - Well-developed characters, setting, and plot.
 - Use of descriptive vocabulary.

- Before answering questions, go back to the text to check the context. This will help you ensure that your responses are accurate and evidence-based.

For Narrative Writing:

- Study the picture prompt and think about the emotions or ideas it inspires.
- Plan your story before writing using a story map or outline.
- Add vivid descriptions, dialogue, and emotions to bring your story to life.
- Check your work for proper grammar, punctuation, and spelling.
