

Applying to St. Rose School for 2026-2027

Grade Six students currently in ECSD Schools

All families must indicate their choice of school through the "Pre-Enrollment for Next Year" Icon on the Parent portal on PowerSchool starting February 2, 2026. Your address will determine which school is your designated junior high school. If the "Pre-Enrollment for Next Year" Icon does not indicate "St. Rose School" you will need to indicate "St. Rose School" as your school of choice. All necessary documents should be emailed to Silvi.Thomas@ecsd.net or brought to St. Rose School.

Grade Six students not currently in an ECSD School

Please proceed to the following [LINK](#) and complete the registration process by clicking on "Register Now." New registrations open on February 2, 2026. Upload all necessary documents through the registration portal. You do not need to wait until February 2 to register for the Accelerated or Honours exam.

Registrations from current ECSD students for grade 8 and 9

Registrations from students outside of ECSD for grade 8 and 9

Please proceed to the following [LINK](#) and complete the registration process by clicking on "Register Now." Upload all necessary documents through the registration portal.

Note:

1. Current ECSD students should submit their birth certificate and relevant immigration papers, report card and a Baptismal Certificate (if applicable) directly to the St. Rose School office to complete the registration package.
2. Non-ECSD registrants should upload all required document to the registration portal.

Applying for St. Rose Focus Programs in 2026-2027

Note: Registration for the Accelerated and Honours Programs is only open for grade seven. Registration is the same format as for the regular program. Refer to the information above.

Additionally: All students seeking admission into our Accelerated and/or Honours Programs must qualify by writing the corresponding entrance exam. An "Exam Sign-up Request Form" must be filled out and submitted. The form can be found on the [St. Rose](#) website under the About tab (top right) under "Registration Documents and Information".

Information about the exams is posted on the "Registration Documents and Information" page. If your child writes an Accelerated or Honours exam, families are notified of admittance two to three weeks after the last exams are written.
